

The TITANIC CENTENARY Silver Ingot Watch

This stylish limited edition watch has been specially commissioned by Danbury Mint to commemorate 100 years since the Titanic sank. Generations have been touched by the tragic journey of the Titanic which ended on the 15th April 1912, when the great 'unsinkable' ship struck an iceberg and plummeted to the seabed. Many souls were lost that day, and only a lucky few survived.

Special Edition – solid silver ingot

The centrepiece of this attractive watch is a brilliant one-gram silver ingot that has been struck with an image of the Titanic along with the centenary dates. The watch features a seconds hand, and sleek raised markers at the 3, 6, 9 and 12 positions. The black face features a delicate textured pattern that makes the silver ingot look even more impressive. The watch is fastened with a genuine leather black strap - perfect for everyday wear or a special occasion. What's more, a precision quartz movement ensures perfect timekeeping.

Now is your opportunity to acquire this special limited edition watch. It will only be made during Titanic's centenary year of 2012.
