



## NOVAK DJOKOVIC

World No.1 Novak Djokovic was awarded the 2011 ITF tennis world champion after the Serb had a dominating 2011, winning three Grand Slams and five ATP Masters 1000 titles. "To have won three Grand Slam titles and finished the year as No.1 is very special," Djokovic said. "I am proud to have been named the ITF world champion for 2011."

When asked to give a recap of 2011 Djokovic answered:

"Starting with victory in last year's Davis Cup final, this has been an almost perfect 12 months for me. I have always dreamed about becoming the best in the world, and to have won three Grand Slam titles and finished the year as No.1 is very special."

Djokovic became the first player besides Roger Federer and Rafael Nadal to hold this coveted trophy after American Andy Roddick won it in 2003.

## PETRA KVITOVA

The young Czech won her first Grand Slam singles title at The Championships, Wimbledon, before following up with victory at the season-ending WTA Championships in Istanbul, and winning the Fed Cup for the Czech Republic against Russia.

Having jumped 32 places in the world rankings to a career-high

position of world No.2, when asked about her feelings towards being named ITF tennis world champion, Kvitová commented, "I will cherish this award, which is the cherry on top of a wonderful year in which I managed to win Wimbledon, the WTA Championships. It was a dream year and something I will never forget."
